Qualifications:

Academic study in natural resources, natural sciences, interpretation, education, recreation, or a related field is advantageous. A valid driver's license is required.

Responsibilities:

- Lead nature walks/hikes
- Lead nature programs for all ages
- Keep interpretive posters and signage current
- Keep wildflower interpretive trail current and labeled
- Weekly checks on the natural playscape
- Assist with watercraft rental station
- Assist staff in the daily maintenance needed throughout the park
- Assist staff in posting to park social media accounts
- Inspecting watercraft for AIS (Aquatic Invasive Species)

Work Schedule:

The workdays run in 8 hour shifts with a total of a 40-hour work week. This internship does have evening and weekend hours. It runs for a total of 10 weeks.
