Roadway Facts

- Annual Average Daily Traffic = 2520 vehicles per day
- County State Aid Highway System – Must follow State Aid Rules
- 12 Reported Crashes in the last 5 years
 - 5 Angle Crashes
 - 4 Single Vehicle/Run off Road Crashes

Existing Issues

- Poor Roadway Condition
- Poor Sight Lines – Hills & Valleys and Intersections
 - Inconsistent Drainage
- Inconsistent Access and Difficult Grades at Access Points



Building the foundation of a vibrant community

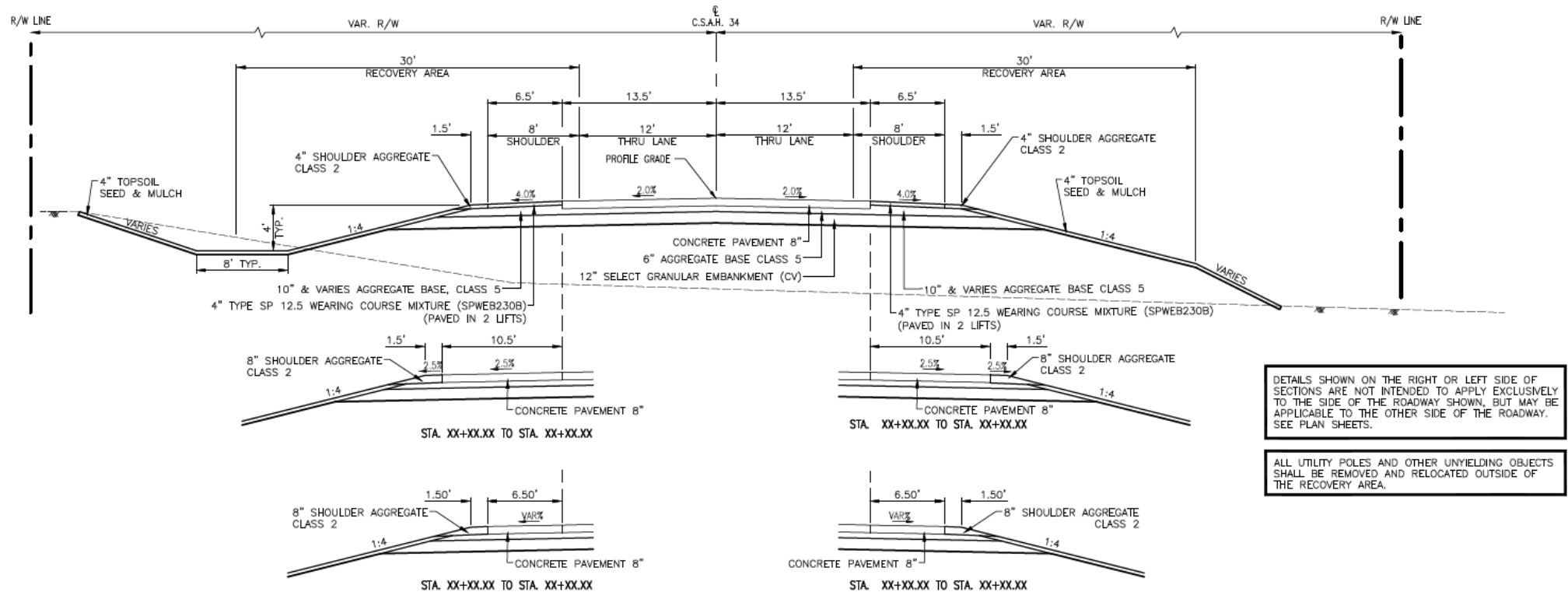
Design Solutions

- Reconstruct Roadway in Concrete – 50-year design life
 - Improve sight lines to meet standards
- Reconstruct with Standard Typical Section – Meets expectations and is consistent with other County State Aid Roads in the Area
- Regrade ditches to standard size to improve flow and accommodate storm events
